Subject: Facts on the impact of the Club for Growth political arms in the Texas Senate Race

Note: The end of this memo includes the complete competitive spending figures for Texas in the final week.

Key points:

- Club for Growth Action's spending on television, radio, and internet in the final weeks of the campaign severely blunted the spending advantage of the Dewhurst campaign.
- Outside spending by Club for Growth Action accounted for over 80% of pro-Cruz independent expenditures. In addition, the Club for Growth PAC bundled nearly \$1 million directly to Cruz's campaign.
- Club for Growth Action ran a highly sophisticated and aggressive internet advertising campaign that delivered nearly 14 million impressions and over 600,000 pre-roll video impressions.

FACT: Without Super-PAC spending on TV, Ted Cruz would have been outspent approximately 7-2 in the final week of the campaign. With outside groups, pro-Cruz forces were only outspent approximately 3-2. Club for Growth Action funded 75% of pro-Cruz TV spending by outside groups and spent twice the amount of money spent by Cruz's own campaign.

- In the final week of the campaign David Dewhurst spent \$2,473,847 on TV while Cruz only spent \$722,286.
- Club for Growth Action spent over double the amount that Ted Cruz's own campaign did in the final week -- \$1,490,540 to \$722,286.
- In the four most expensive media markets:
 - 1. Dewhurst outspent Cruz more than 9-2 in Dallas without outside groups. 2-1 with outside groups.
 - 2. Dewhurst outspent Cruz nearly 3-1 in Houston without outside groups. 3-2 with outside groups.
 - 3. Dewhurst outspent Cruz over 3-1 in San Antonio without outside groups. 6-5 with outside groups.
 - 4. Dewhurst outspent Cruz more than 7-2 in Austin without outside groups, 7-5 with outside groups.
- With outside spending led by Club for Growth Action, pro-Cruz advertising was more than pro-Dewhurst spending in seven smaller markets.

FACT: Club for Growth Action spent \$5.5 million on independent expenditures, accounting for 83% of all pro-Cruz outside spending.

- Club for Growth Action spent \$5,478,417 on independent expenditures in the Texas Senate campaign, 83% of total pro-Cruz outside spending.
- In addition to independent expenditures by Club for Growth Action, the Club for Growth PAC bundled \$891,138 in direct contributions from Club members to Cruz's campaign.
- The \$891,138 bundled by the Club for Growth PAC amounted to just over 10% of all contributions raised by Ted Cruz throughout his entire campaign.
- The \$891,138 bundled by the Club for Growth PAC is more than what Ted Cruz's campaign spent on TV in the final week.
- The \$891,138 bundled by the Club for Growth PAC is nearly 30 times more than the leading Democrat Senate candidate, Paul Sadler, has in cash on hand for his campaign.

FACT: Club for Growth Action spent over \$650,000 total on an aggressive internet advertising campaign in both the primary and runoff.

- As of Thursday, 7/26, Club for Growth Action delivered more than 13.6 million impressions of anti-Dewhurst banner advertising in just the runoff.
- As of 7/26, 635,000 pre-roll video views of anti-Dewhurst messages have taken place with 80% of the viewers completing the video.
- Over 4 million people have been reached by the Facebook advertising.

CONCLUSION: Club for Growth Action has played an important factor in the Texas Senate Race on behalf of Ted Cruz. After playing a similar role in the defeat of Senator Richard Lugar (R-IN), Club for Growth Action is set to play a major role in the composition of the United States Senate next year.
